Information relating to the transactions and activities of the Fund has been supplied in a timely manner.


### **Meetings**

In preparation for your examination of the special purpose financial report of the **A & S HUGHES-D'AETH SUPER FUND** as at 30 June 2021, the following representations are made which are true to the best of our knowledge and belief:

**1. Risk of Fraud**

**2. Procedures for Identifying and Responding to Fraud**


