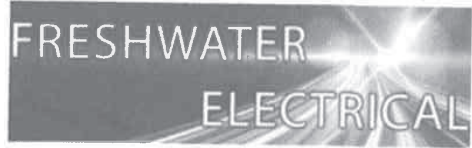

Hi Alwis,

Hope you are doing OK and business is improving. I had planned to be in Cairns last week to follow up on the pool and meet with Peter Raby (Pete's Painting) who will be doing the exterior painting. Unfortunately I've had my leg in plaster since Sept 18th and it will be about another five weeks before I can walk again.

The pool: As Jay is aware we need a pool builder to replace the underground plumbing and would like to do a complete makeover involving resurfacing the pool and whatever else it needs. I explained to Jay in August that the pool builders I approached were busy doing new pools and weren't interested. Jay did say that we would make enquiries himself but I presume he didn't get anywhere with that.

I will be up there in November as soon as I can get around and get it booked in somehow. From the size of your water statements I'd say the quantities you are putting in to it are relatively small. Having said that I realise the continual topping up is a pain in the arse. I wish I could be more help.

Re the cooktops / oven stoves: The three upright stoves in 208, 210 and 212 – I will assess them in November, repair them if feasible, replace them if, as you suggest, they are past it. As for the two and four plate cooktops, it is not possible to replace those (10 amp) appliances with 45 amp oven ranges. There is not the capacity in the building electrics. Even if we upgrade cabling to each of the units the switchboard is just about flat out. No way we could add a couple of hundred amps. As for the mains to the board, I doubt if there would be sufficient capacity there either.

You haven't been specific about the glass cooktops themselves – the two-plate appliances in 227, 228 and 225, are there any problems with them? I'm guessing the 4-plate appliances in 224 and 226 are OK, being relatively new.

Please come back with any immediate problems with the above that can't wait until I get there in October, and I'll arrange for an electrician to see what he can do.
