Objectives and Scope of the Audit

- (h) The Trustee(s) have complied with all investment standards set out in the SISA and the SISA.
- (i) Information retention obligations have been complied with.
- (j) All contributions accepted and benefits paid have been in accordance with the governing rules of the fund and relevant provisions of the SISA and the SISR.


