In preparation for your examination of the special purpose financial report of the **Gail Kerbel Superannuation Fund** as at 30 June 2021, the following representations are made which are true to the best of our knowledge and belief:

## 1. Risk of Fraud

The risk that the financial report is materially misstated due to fraud is considered to be low as a result of the following:

- a) The trustee's are signatories on all transactions, no other party has the authority to act on behalf of the trustee; and

## Scope
