Dear Sydney Gas Shareholder



AGL's Recommended Takeover Offer

As you would be aware, AGL Energy Limited (**AGL**) has announced an off-market takeover offer (**Offer**) for all of the issued shares in Sydney Gas Limited (**SGL**) at a price of 42.5 cents per SGL share. In respect of your shareholding in SGL, AGL's offer would translate into a payment to you of **\$1,275.00** that would be paid no later than 3 business days after the receipt of a valid acceptance.

I am writing to give you an update on the status of AGL's Offer and to encourage you to accept the Offer before its scheduled closing date of 13 February 2009.

By now you would have received copies of both AGL's Bidder's Statement and SGL's Target's Statement. The Target's Statement sent to you by SGL includes the unanimous recommendation of SGL's Directors that SGL shareholders accept AGL's Offer in the absence of a superior proposal. The SGL Directors also state in the Target's Statement that they intend to accept AGL's Offer in respect of the SGL shares they own or control personally, in the absence of a superior proposal.

Shortly after the release of its Target's Statement, SGL's two major shareholders, A J Lucas Group and Babcock & Brown, sold their entire SGL shareholdings to AGL through on-market transactions. At the time of writing, AGL has voting power in SGL of approximately 78%. As noted in its Bidder's Statement, AGL intends to compulsorily acquire all outstanding SGL shares if it becomes entitled to do so.

On 27 January 2009, AGL declared its Offer unconditional and advised that it will dispatch cheques to shareholders who accept AGL's Offer no later than 3 business days after the receipt by AGL of their valid acceptance.

AGL's Offer price represents a 55% premium to the closing price of SGL shares on 22 December 2008, the last trading day before the Offer was announced, and a 117% premium to the volume weighted average of the prices at which SGL shares traded over the 30 trading days prior to that day.

The Offer of 42.5 cents per share is unconditional and provides a certain return for SGL shareholders. I commend it to you and encourage you to accept the Offer prior to its scheduled close on 13 February 2009.

To accept the Offer and receive payment for your shares, you should accept the Offer in accordance with the instructions contained in the enclosed Acceptance Form. 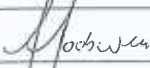
