### **Audit Engagement Letter**

#### **Objectives and Scope of the Audit**

You have requested that we audit the financial statements of the THE D A WATSON SUPERANNUATION FUND for the year ended 30/06/2023. We are pleased to confirm our acceptance and understanding of this engagement by means of this letter.

Our audit will be performed in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards, the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993 (SISA)* and the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Regulations (SISR)* with the objective of expressing an opinion on the financial report and the fund's compliance with the specified requirements of the SISA and the SISR.

#### **Our Responsibilities**

We will conduct our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Those Auditing Standards require that we comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance as to whether the financial report is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing audit procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. 


