The trustees have endeavoured to obtain from the Directors of the following unlisted investments market values at 30/06/2022 and changes in official paperwork to reflect the ownership as being directly held by the Gunzburg Super Fund (versus the current ownership being reflected as Blue Bear Pty Ltd in trust for the Gunzburg Super Fund). Despite the efforts of the Trustees, the changes to the ownership documentation and written confirmation of carrying values are unable to be provided at this time due to a number of factors. These include the difficulty associated with valuations of unlisted investments, valuations not being reflected in any prepared financial statements for the year ending 30/6/2022, and the reluctance of the current directors to either complete this process or provide other assurances as to current market value. Therefore, as trustees, we have made our own enquiries and state the values based on a realistic appraisal of current market conditions. The trustees will continue to work towards obtaining a change in official documentation with the current Directors of these unlisted investments despite the lack of response provided by them to date. The reason for the later problem is the state of disagreement which exists between various interested parties and management of these investments.

**A statutory declaration under the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959* may be made before—**
