The preserved portion of your withdrawal benefit is the amount which cannot be paid out until you permanently retire from the workforce on or after age 55. The preservation age is to be increased from 55 to 60, on a phased in basis, by 2025.

Withdrawing Funds

Eligible Rollover Fund

The Fund has selected an 'eligible rollover fund' to which it will transfer benefits belonging to 'lost' members or unclaimed benefits.

Government regulations define members as 'lost' if two consecutive reports, sent at least six months apart, are returned unclaimed to the fund.
