Investment Strategy

THE PROKSCHA FAMILY SUPERANNUATION FUND

Paragraph 52(2)(f) of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993 ("SIS") requires Prokscha Investments Pty Ltd ACN 101 534 025 in its capacity as Trustee ("Trustee") of the Prokscha Family Superannuation Fund ("Fund") to formulate an investment strategy for the Fund that has regard to the whole of the circumstances of the Fund.

An investment strategy is a plan for making, holding and realising Fund assets consistent with the investment objectives adopted for the Fund.

In formulating an investment strategy regard must be had to the whole of the circumstances of the Fund including, but not limited to:

- the risk involved in making, and the likely return from, investments;
- the membership profile of the Fund;
- the size of the Fund;
- the composition of the Fund's investments as a whole, including the extent to which the investments are diverse or involve the Trustee in being exposed to the risk from inadequate diversification;
- the liquidity of the Fund's investments having regard to expected cash flow requirements;
- the ability of the Fund to discharge its existing and prospective liabilities; and
- the Trustee's duties and powers as trustee being performed and exercised in the best interests of the members of the Fund.

Objectives

The Trustee of the fund aims to:

- provide superannuation benefits to members to meet their retirement interests.
- ensure that an appropriate mix of assets is owned by the fund.

The Trustee's general investment objective is to achieve real medium to longer term growth, while maintaining a low level of capital volatility.

To achieve this objective, the Trustee(s) have determined the fund will have the ability to invest in the following areas:

- equities and stocks including the participation in dividend reinvestment programs, rights issues and any other investments offered in this area;
- property trusts and associated investments;
- managed investments and associated products thereof;
- direct property investment;
- solicitors first mortgages and associated investments thereof;
- cash/interest bearing deposits; and
- any other investment legally able to be made.

It is noted that the Trustee may from time to time seek professional advice in the formulation of an investment strategy.

In determining this strategy the Trustee(s) have taken into consideration the aspects of the investment in accordance with the fund's objectives and appropriate legislation.

Policies

The policies adopted by the Trustee to adhere to these objectives are:

- Continual monitoring of the performance of the funds investments, rates of return, risk analysis and expected cash flow requirements.
- Balancing the asset portfolio as a result of adjustments to market conditions.

The Trustee will ensure investments continue to comply with the strategy, however, the Trustee reserves the right to alter the strategy at any time.
